We are excited to offer several pathways you can choose for your child to learn with us and engage in our community. Each of these pathways can be chosen as an individual experience or can be paired with other, additional pathways to create a unique set of learning and engagement opportunities for your child(ren). Below are more detailed descriptions of our programs.

K12 EDUCATION

Learning about the Jewish holidays, lifecycle events, Torah stories, Israel, Jewish values and much more. Every class participates in a beautifully designed, highly musical T'filah service. Students learn foundational Hebrew, prayers, and blessings. The Hebrew Through Movement curriculum is one of the ways we teach and practice vocabulary.

- When: Sunday mornings from 9:30-12 OR Tuesday afternoons 4:00-6:00 pm
- Who: Students in PreK to 6th grade
- Cost: \$1,815 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

2ND GRADE B'YACHAD

A new addition to our Sunday School program. In addition to our 2nd grade curriculum which includes Torah stories, Jewish holidays and Mussar, the 2nd Grade B'Yachad class will have a family component. Parents will join the children one Sunday per month during the school year. There will be learning with the children and time for adult learning.

- When: Sunday mornings from 9:30am-12:00pm
- Who: Students in 2nd grade
- Cost: \$1,815 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

POP-UP CHOIR

Temple Isaiah's Pop-Up Choir now "pops up" just about every Sunday! Our choir will meet every week when Sunday School is in session to learn songs, have fun and prepare to perform for the High Holy Days, Simchat Torah, Hanukkah, Shabbat and more. Come for a pizza lunch and fun singing with Cantor Schloss and Song Leader Sophie Feldman.

- When: Sundays when K12 Education is in session from 12:00pm-12:45pm
- Who: Students in TK-6th grade
- Cost: No additional cost

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HEBREW INTENSIVE

An ideal opportunity for those students looking to deepen their knowledge of Hebrew. Students in this class will have a speedy review of Hebrew letters and vowels and quickly dive into decoding practice primarily using the texts of prayers and blessings. New for this year, we offer this class on Sunday mornings and Tuesday afternoons.

- When: Sunday mornings 9:30am-12:00pm OR Tuesday afternoons 4:00pm-6:00pm
- Who: Students in 4th-6th grades
- Cost: \$1,815 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

HEBREW TUTORING 1-1

For students of all ages and grades, this program will pair one of our Hebrew tutors with your child and they will meet once a week - or more often, depending on your needs, for 30-minute sessions. Students can choose to meet on Zoom or in-person. This program is primarily for students who need extra support beyond in-class Hebrew learning, or to supplement students' B'nei Mitzvah preparation. This can also be a great option for new students in grades 5th or 6th who have not had any prior Hebrew instruction.

- When: Tell us your availability. Different days/times available.
- Who: Students in all grades
- Cost: \$340/8 sessions. All sessions are 30 minutes long.

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TEEN SCHOOL:

Designed for 7th to 12th graders, all teens begin the evening enjoying dinner together, connecting and socializing with friends. The foundation of our curriculum is Jewish values: this carries through to each grade and class's individual focus, including but not limited to the spiritual practice of mussar, Jewish philanthropy, civil rights, Israel, and the Holocaust. Students learn with beloved teachers and clergy throughout the year.

- When: Tuesday evenings 6:00pm-8:00pm
- Who: Students in 7th to 12th grade
- Cost: \$1,990 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)
- 10th, 11th & 12th grade class is 18 weeks only. Cost is \$1,490 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

TUESDAY NIGHT INNOVATION LAB:

Ever wanted to learn the art of podcasting? Curious about digital media project creation? Have a list of ideas for Jewish storytelling through TikTok? If yes, join us on Tuesday evenings in the Kleinrock Schuler Center for Innovation as we explore the new frontier of Jewish engagement. Learn from experts in the field (including the creator of the Internet!) and get ready to play.

- When: Tuesday evenings 6:00pm-8:00pm
- Who: Students in 9th to 12th grade
- Cost: \$1,490 (Includes K12 Security and RSPA Fees)

RISHONIM-IN-TRAINING - 7TH GRADE:

Our outstanding "Rishonim" program for teens continues to grow and evolve! We are excited to welcome seventh graders to serve as "Rishonim-in-Training" where they will learn the building blocks of serving as teaching assistants and leaders in K12 Education!

Rishonim-in-Training will:

- Assist on Sunday mornings in K12 Department.
- Assist on Sunday mornings with specialists (art, T'filah & music, etc.) and on special projects (Shofar Factory, L' Dough Va Dough)
- Receive mentorship from Rishonim (10th-12th graders) and teachers.
- Participate in professional development tailored to their age and grade level.
- When: Sunday 9:30am-12:00pm
- Who: Students in 7th grade
- Cost: \$900

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JUNIOR RISHONIM – 8TH & 9TH GRADE:

Eighth and ninth graders who wish to deepen their connection to the Isaiah community and continue growing as Jewish leaders are invited to serve as Junior Rishonim. Prior experience as “Rishonim-in-Training” is not required.

- When: Sunday 9:30am-12:00pm
- Who: Students in 8th and 9th grade
- Cost: No cost! This is a volunteer program. Teens will receive credit for their hours to be used as needed for school service hours.

RISHONIM FELLOWSHIP:

Teens in grades 10th-12th are invited to apply to the Rishonim Fellowship. Rishonim participate on Sunday mornings and/or Tuesday afternoons, supporting teachers in our classrooms or assisting in the K12 Department. Fellows receive a generous stipend, thanks to our congregant Gail Solo and the Gail Solo Youth Opportunity Scholarship Fund.

In addition to special learning sessions focused on Jewish education, Rishonim will participate in monthly **professional development** class focused on critical “life” skills: how to write a resume / CV, how to interview for a job, how to balance a checkbook, paying taxes, etc.! This new aspect of our Rishonim program will include sessions and connection opportunities with Isaiah professionals who are noted experts in their fields. Additionally, Rishonim will have the opportunity to serve as mentors for Rishonim-in-Training and Junior Rishonim throughout the year.

- When: Sunday mornings 9:15am-12:15pm and/or Tuesdays 4:00pm-6:00pm
- Who: 10th-12th graders
- Cost: No cost! Rishonim receive a \$2000 stipend for the year.

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
