We are excited to offer several pathways you can choose for your child to learn with us and engage in our community. Each of these pathways can be chosen as an individual experience or can be paired with other pathways to create a unique and robust set of learning and engagement opportunities for your children. Below are more detailed descriptions.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

Learning about the Jewish holidays, lifecycle events, Torah stories, Israel, Jewish values and much more. Every class participates in a beautifully designed highly musical T'filah service. Students learn foundational Hebrew, prayers, and blessings. The Hebrew Through Movement curriculum is one of the ways we teach and practice vocabulary. Mornings begin with bagels for parents and students from 9:00am-9:30am.

- Who: Students in TK-6th grades
- Tuition: \$1,900 (Includes K12 Security and Religious School Parent Association (RSPA) Fees)

POP-UP CHOIR

Temple Isaiah's Pop-Up Choir sings together most Sundays! The choir will meet every week when Sunday School is in session to learn songs, have fun and get ready to perform for High Holy Days, Simchat Torah, Hanukkah, Shabbat and more. Come for a pizza lunch and fun singing with Cantor Schloss and our songleader, Sophie Feldman.

- Who: Students in TK-6th grades
- Tuition: No additional cost

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HEBREW INTENSIVE

An ideal opportunity for those students looking to deepen their knowledge of Hebrew. Students in this class will have a speedy review of Hebrew letters and vowels and quickly dive into decoding practice primarily using the texts of prayers and blessings.

- When: Tuesday afternoons 4:00-6:00 pm
- Who: Students in 4th-6th grades
- Tuition: \$1,900 (Includes K12 Security and Religious School Parent Association (RSPA) Fees)

HEBREW TUTORING 1-1

For students in all grades, this program will pair one of our Hebrew tutors with your child and they will meet once a week – or more often, depending on your needs – for 30-minute sessions. Students can choose to meet in-person at the temple or on Zoom. This program is for students who need extra support beyond in class Hebrew learning, prior to B'nei Mitzvah preparation, or, for new students in grades 5th or 6th who have not had any prior Hebrew instruction.

- When: Tell us your availability. Different days and times available.
- Who: Students in all grades
- Tuition: \$360 for 8 sessions All sessions are 30 minutes long.

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TEEN SCHOOL:

Designed for 7th to 12th graders, all teens begin the evening enjoying dinner together, connecting and socializing with friends. The foundation of our teen school is Jewish values: this carries through to each grade and class' individual focus, including but not limited to the spiritual practice of mussar, Jewish philanthropy, civil rights, Israel and the Holocaust.

- When: Tuesday evenings 6:00-8:00 pm
- Who: Teens in 7th-12th grades
- Tuition: \$2,075 (Includes K12 Security and Religious School Parent Association (RSPA) Fees)

RISHONIM-IN-TRAINING LEADERSHIP PROGRAM - 7TH GRADE

Our outstanding Rishonim program for teens continues to grow and evolve! We are excited to welcome seventh graders to serve as Rishonim-in-Training where they will learn the building blocks of serving as teaching assistants and leaders in K12 Education!

Rishonim-in-Training will:

- Assist on Sunday mornings in K12 Department.
 - Assist on Sunday mornings with school specialists (art, music and/or t'filah)
 - Receive mentorship from older Rishonim and teachers.
 - Participate in professional development tailored to their age and grade level.
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- When: Sunday 9:00 am-12:15 pm
 - Who: Teens in 7th grade
 - Tuition: \$900
 - Note: Professional Development meetings will be held at different times. During school hours or after school until 1:30 pm at the latest.

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JUNIOR RISHONIM LEADERSHIP PROGRAM- 8TH & 9TH GRADE

8th and 9th graders who wish to deepen their connection to the Isaiah community and continue growing as Jewish leaders are invited to serve as Junior Rishonim. Prior experience as Rishonim-in-Training is not required.

- When: Sunday 9:00 am-12:15 pm
- Who: Teens in 8th and 9th grade
- Compensation: No cost! This is a volunteer program. Teens will receive credit for their hours to be used as needed for school service hours.
- Note: Professional Development meetings will be held at different times. During school hours or after school until 1:30 pm at the latest.

RISHONIM LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Teens in 10th-12th grade are invited to apply to the Rishonim Leadership Program. Rishonim participate on Sunday mornings and/or Tuesday afternoons, supporting teachers in our classrooms or assisting in the K12 Department. Rishonim receive a generous stipend, thanks to our congregant Gail Solo and the Gail Solo Youth Opportunity Scholarship Fund.

In addition to special learning sessions focused on Jewish education, Rishonim will participate in monthly professional development sessions focused on different topics and will include connection opportunities with Isaiah professionals who are noted experts in their fields.

- When: Sunday mornings 9:00 am-12:15 pm and/or Tuesdays 4:00-6:00 pm (Tuesday positions are limited)
- Who: Teens in 10th-12th grades
- Compensation: No cost! Rishonim will receive a \$2000 stipend.
- Note: Professional Development meetings will be held at different times. After school until 1:30 pm at the latest.

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
